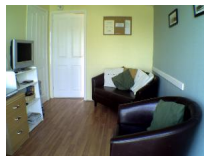

Caravan location: Cornwall/Atlantic Bays HolidayPark - 6 berth



Caravan description:

Atlantic Bays Holiday Park (Formerly Point Curlew Holiday Park) is situated just two miles from the beautiful harbour town of PADSTOW and 10 miles from NEWQUAY. Buses run frequently from just across the road to many local areas, including most of the beaches.

The site has a family friendly atmosphere, with ample space for children to run and play, and safe areas for barbeques.

There are many places to eat out locally, and good shops in St Merryn, about 1/2 a mile away. The clubhouse facilities are currently undergoing extensive rebuilding works, and are unusable, but there is a bar with entertainment on the Maribu site, just across the road, which our guests are free to use. Also across the road is a Chinese Takeaway and an Indian restaurant & Takeaway and an award winning Fish&Chip shop in St Merryn.
